In the month of Oct^r 1831 in consequence of the
pressing invitation of the Presbytery and also the
willing desire of the American Brethren two
members Nathaniel Bishop with his wife under
took to leave Danbury and cross the Atlantic to
visit the churches in Britain they accordingly
came by one of the usual Packets and after a fair
voyage of Days landed at Liverpool from whence
they proceeded by Steam to Glasgow when they met
the Elders of the whole Church and for the first time
saw the complete Order of a Church of Christ, and
partook of the Lords Supper and Communion together
as members of that one Body on Earth of which
Christ is the head, after staying there Sabbath
they proceeded to Dundee where they were received
